Registration Form and entry fees must be received by September 10, 2011

.Entry Fee: \$50.00 per category, \$150 allows you to compete in all categories (You may elect to compete in fewer categories; it is not required that you compete in all three). Three categories will be judged, Chicken, Pork Ribs, and Tri Tips. Entrants competing for the optional "Peoples' Choice" \$100 cash prize, in each category, must cook at least 100 toothpick sized servings of meat, to serve to the public, for each category entered, in addition to the official sample submitted for judging. You may not enter the Peoples' Choice competition unless you competed in the same official meat category. (You cannot compete in tri-tip competition only and then i.e. enter the Peoples' Choice chicken competition) We will accept 25 entrants maximum on a first received first serve basis. If we receive more than 25 applications, preference will be given to those who sign up to compete in more than one category.

Contestants must furnish their own BBQ, smoker, grill or cooking vessel. While wood or charcoal heat is preferred, propane may be used. Water and electricity will be available, contestants must bring a working fire extinguisher and we suggest that they bring a shade canopy. **Contestants must review the on line Mariposa Temporary Food Facility Guidelines and obtain a free one day permit from the County of Mariposa. (A Mariposa Permit is mandatory-annual or one day permit accepted) A common "shared" approved screened in area is provided for competitors who do not have one. (Please mail the application to the Mariposa County Department of Health). Please retain a copy for yourself.**

Spaces are approximately 15' x 20'. RV Space available, if needed, next to your cooker may be available depending upon the number of entrants.

Check in time starts at 12:00 P.M. on Friday and ends at 6:30 A.M. on Saturday. The cooks meeting will start at 7:00 P.M. on Friday for early check ins and 7:00 A.M. on Saturday for regular check ins. More information is available on line. Please familiarize yourself with the Judge rules, and BBQ rules and regulations. Judging will begin on Saturday, at a time to be announced, starting at approximately 2:00 P.M. with the "Chicken" category.
